

Children’s Product Safety Enhancement and Clarification Act

Section-by-Section

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the ‘‘Children’s Product Safety Enhancement and Clarification Act of 2009’’

SEC. 2. MANDATORY EXCLUSION OF FABRIC PRODUCTS FROM LEAD LIMITS; SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS IN ENFORCEMENT WITH RESPECT TO SMALL BUSINESSES, THRIFT STORES SELLING USED GOODS, AND DONATIONS TO CHARITIES.

* Provides an exclusion for products made solely of fabric from the lead testing requirements of the Consumer Products Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA).

* Provides that the Consumer Product Safety Commission shall work cooperatively small business, thrift stores selling used goods, and donations made to charitable organizations, in administering the CPSIA, taking into account economic, administrative, or other limits on the ability of the entity to comply with this section.

SEC. 3. EXEMPTION OF FABRIC PRODUCTS FROM MANDATORY THIRD PARTY TESTING FOR LEAD CONTENT.
